Harry G. Lucas, 88, of Brownstown died at 11:30 p.m. Saturday at his home.

He was a member of Brownstown United Methodist Church and co-founder and former co-owner of Lucas-Ackerman Building Center in Brownstown. He was a member of Washington Lodge F&AM, Brownstown, and former member of the Brownstown School Board and Brownstown Medical Board.
