Funeral services for Ray L. Lucas, 65, of Norman Rt. 1 were at 10 a.m. Tuesday, March 31, at Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home in Brownstown where the Rev. David Fisher officiated and burial was in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Lucas died unexpectedly at 8 p.m. Friday, March 27, at home.

He is survived by his wife, the former Helen Jean Wray, whom he married Jan. 22, 1945, in Jackson County.
