Rites Held Sunday For Mrs. Rosa Lucas

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene for Mrs. Rosa Lucas, well known Brownstown resident, who died at 3:00 o'clock Friday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Schwein, and Mr. Schwein, with whom she had made her home for a number of years.

In failing health for several years, Mrs. Lucas had been bedfast for a week.

The Rev. Edsel Granger, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, and the Rev. Don Ratliff, Nazarene pastor, were in charge of the funeral rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

Mrs. Lucas, who would have been sixty-one years old last Saturday, was born February 7, 1898, in Owen township, a daughter of the late Mart and Margaret Goss Butler. She had spent all of her life in this vicinity.
