Charles McCasland Dies At Hospital

Charles T. McCasland, 64, who lived at 223 South Broadway in Seymour, died last Thursday at the Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital following an illness of six months' duration.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon from the Voss Chapel, Seymour, in charge of the Rev. Wilbert Vandervort, pastor of the Wesleyan Church. Interment was in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.

A native of Crothersville, Mr. McCasland was born December 16, 1904, a son of the late Claude and Nancy Rude McCasland. He was a retired employee of the Gerwin Shoe Company, of Seymour.
