MRS. ALETHA McCORMICK DIES AT BROWNSTOWN

Widow of Former County Health
Officer Passes—Relatives
Live Here.

Mrs. Aletha A. McCormick, age eighty-five, well known resident of Brownstown and widow of the late Dr. L. R. McCormick, died at the home on South Main street in Brownstown at 12:30 o'clock this morning. She had been in failing health for several months and had been bedfast for the past month.

Mrs. McCormick was a native of Philadelphia, Pa., where she was born on February 2, 1848. She was the daughter of Lavenia L. and Henry B. Woolls, pioneer residents of Seymour. She lived for a number of years at Crothersville where Dr. McCormick was a practicing physician. He later retired and they moved to Brownstown where Dr. McCormick held the position of county health officer. He died in 1929. They were married at Jeffersonville in 1874. She was a lifelong member of the Methodist Church.

Mrs. McCormick had no children. Surviving is a sister, Miss Sarah E. Woolls; one brother, Lew S. Woolls, and several nephews, all of Seymour.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Wallace Funeral Home at Brownstown with the Rev. J. E. Nichols, of Brownstown, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
