Mr. Lawrence D. "Larry" McCory, 72, of Brownstown, Indiana, passed away unexpectedly at 8:46 p.m. Thursday, January 21, 2010 at Schneck Medical Center in Seymour, IN.

Larry was a member of The Crossing in Columbus, Indiana. For the past 16 years he owned and operated Logos Enterprises. He was a 1955 graduate of Brownstown High School and he earned his Bachelor of Science Degree from Franklin College in 1959 where he graduated Suma Cum Laude. While at Franklin College, he studied in Austria in his junior year. He earned his Master of Science Degree from the University of Wisconsin in 1961. He also was a member of the Phi Beta Kappa fraternity. He was a past member of the Board of Trustees for Brownstown Community School Corp., and was a former member of the Fairview Cemetery Association.

Born April 13, 1937, in Jackson County, he was a son of the late Foster and Ruby McCollum McCory. On June 13, 1959, in Brownstown, he married Judy Robertson, who survives.
