Heart Attack Fatal To Charles P. McCrary— Burial Rites Here

Charles P. McCrary, of Indianapolis, native of Brownstown and a brother of James McCrary and Clyde McCrary, here, died Friday at Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis, following a coronary attack suffered three days earlier.

Funeral rites were held Monday afternoon at the Barth Place Methodist Church in Indianapolis, followed by burial in Fairview Competency in Brownstown

Mr. McCrary, who was 59 years old, was born July, 1896, in Brownstown, the son of the late Samuel and Evelyn Clark McCrary. He was married here in 1917 to Wilmeth Hamilton, who survives.
