Mrs. Dovy McCrary Dies At Capital—Rites Held Here This Morning

Funeral rites were held at 10 o'clock this morning from the Winklepleck Funeral Home here for Mrs. Dovy Alice McCrary, 76, native and life-long resident of Brownstown, who died shortly after noon Sunday in General Hospital, Indianapolis.

In failing health for several years, Mrs. McCrary had been seriously ill for the past six weeks.

Gene Dulin, pastor of the Brownstown Christian Church, of which the deceased was a member, was in charge of the funeral service and interment was in Fairview Cemetery.

Born in Brownstown on February 4, 1880, Mrs. McCrary was a daughter of the late Marion and Eliza White Hatton. On September 28, 1909, she was married in Paris, Illinois, to Orvia Wineinger and on May 20, 1925 was married to James Elba McCrary, who died in June of 1946.

One daughter, Mrs. Alyce Eubanks, of Indianapolis, a registered nurse, survives as does a brother, C. M. Hatton, of Indianapolis. One brother is deceased.
