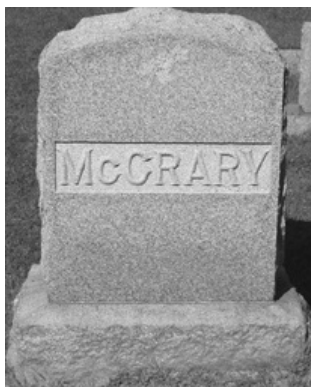

James A. McCrary Dies In Clark Co. Hospital— Rites At Seymour Thurs.

James A. McCrary, 74, Brownstown R1, who for a number of years operated a trucking service here, died Monday morning in the Clark County Hospital, Jeffersonville. He had been ill for several weeks.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson county, he was born December 31, 1887, a son of the late Samuel and Evaline Clark McCrary.

He was thrice married. His first wife, whom he married in 1911, was Nellie Hornaday. Following her death he was married in 1919, to the late Emma Browning Lahrman, and in 1939 married Jessie Cox Beldon, also deceased.

Surviving are three children, George McCrary and Mrs. Dennis Durkoop, of Seymour, and Thomas W. McCrary, Jeffersonville; five step-children, Earl G. Lahrman, Crothersville, Mrs. John E. Fox, Seymour, Lloyd Lahrman, Denver, Colorado, Howard Beldon, Tampico, and Mrs. Beatrice Taul, Eckerty, Indiana.

He also leaves a brother, Clyde McCrary, Seymour; a sister, Mrs. Grace Jackson, Lebanon; 16 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

A daughter, Mrs. Mary Jane Rucker, of Seymour, died suddenly on March 14, this year.

Funeral rites have been set for 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Voss Chapel, Seymour, in charge of the Rev. Walter C. Loeber, pastor of the Seymour Redeemer Lutheran Church. The funeral party will come immediately to Brownstown for burial in Fairview Cemetery.
