McCrary—John O. McCrary, 64, a life-long resident of Brownstown, died at the county hospital in Seymour Monday afternoon, where he had been admitted Sunday for treatment. He had been in failing health since December.

Funeral services were conducted at the Christian church this afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. E. E. Pedicord in charge. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mr. McCrary was born January 13, 1883, the son of Samuel and Evelyn Clark McCrary, both deceased. He was married in Brownstown on October 6, 1917, to LaVesta Hurley, who survives.

For a number of years he was employed at the Jersey Dale Dairy and later was appointed custodian of the Brownstown grade schools. He was an active member of the Brownstown Christian church and was well known.

Surviving besides the widow are two children, Raymond McCrary and Mrs. Robert Gatte, both of Brownstown; three brothers, James and Clyde McCrary, of Brownstown; Chas. P. McCrary, of Indianapolis, and a sister, Mrs. Raymond Jackson, of Lebanon.
