LaVesta McCrary, 93, Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown, died at 10:25 p.m. Thursday, June 2, at the nursing home. She had been ill for three years.

A former teacher, she also served as assistant postmistress at Brownstown. She graduated from Central Normal College of Danville and then received a degree in elementary education from Indiana University in 1955. She was a member of the Brownstown Order of Eastern Star Chapter 264 for more than 50 years and a member of the National Retired Teachers Assn., Jackson County Retired Teachers Assn., and Indiana University Alumni Assn.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, she was born Aug. 22, 1894, in Jackson County to the late George W. and Louisa Catherine Emmert Hurley. On Oct. 6, 1917, she married John O. McCrary in Brownstown, and he died Aug. 4, 1947.

Survivors include one son: Claude Raymond McCrary, Brownstown; one daughter: Mrs. Robert (Ava) Gatte, Brownstown; five grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by one brother and two sisters.
