Obituary

McCrary—William McCrary, 64, died at his home in Brownstown this morning at 7:30 o'clock. He had been in failing health since October but seemed to be better lately. He accompanied his wife this morning to the Kieffer Paper Mill, where she has been employed for some time. On his return home he was taken sick and passed away unexpectedly.
