

Scott McElfresh, age seventyfive, residing on a Brownstown
rural route two miles northwest
of the county seat, died at 5:15
o'clock this morning. Death followed an illness of four years'
duration. His condition had been
serious for the past three weeks.
Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 o'clock Monday
afternoon from the Pleasant
Grove Methodist Church followed by burial in Fairview Cem-

etery, Brownstown.
