Dr. David McGarvey, 90, died Wednesday, June 22, in Sarasota, Fla.

A commander in the Navy Medical Corps during World War II, he was a practicing physician in Rochester, N.Y. from 1921 until 1956 when he retired. A 1921 graduate of Hahnemann Medical College, Philadelphia, Pa., he was a former member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church and the Seymour Country Club.

Dr. McGarvey, who lived two years in Jackson County, was born Jan. 6, 1898, in Renovo, Pa., to the late Henry A. and Emma Leisher. On Dec. 26, 1928, he married Virginia Belle Kieffer in Brownstown, and she survives.

Other survivors include one son: David Kieffer McGarvey, Silver Springs, Md. and Sarasota, Fla.; one brother, two granddaughters, and one great-grandson.

A graveside service will begin at 10 a.m. Monday, July 25, at Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown, with the Rev. E. Duane Aelick officiating. Spurgeon Funeral Home, Brownstown, handled the arrangements. There will be no public calling.
