Mrs. Rose N. McGee Is Called by Death

Mrs. Rose Nell Zaring McGee, age forty-five, a former Jackson county resident who had been living at Ruston, Louisiana, died late Monday night at the Bartholomew County Hospital at Columbus. She had been ill for three days and had been in the hospital for only one day.
