## DEATH RECORD.

McGinnis—Mrs. Pearl McGinnis, wife of James McGinnis, passed away at the home of her brother, Will Barkman, south of Brownstown, of tuberculosis Friday morning, November 23, aged 24 years and 7 months.

She had been in failing health for a year. In June she was taken to the home of her brother, where all that loving hands could do for her was done, but to no avail.

Mrs. McGinnis was the daughter of Mrs. Dorothy Barkman and was born in Brownstown April 23, 1899. On May 1, 1915, she was united in marriage to James McGinnis of Shelbyville and to their union were born two children.

Besides her mother and husband she leaves two children, Catherine, aged eight, and Delmas, aged three and a half years. She also leaves two brothers and five sisters: George, of South Bend; Will, and Mrs. Maye Snider, of Brownstown; Mrs. Hannelta Knight and Mrs. Sarah Wooten, of Indianapolis; Mrs. Alice Akers, of Rockville and Mrs. Anna Shelton, of Vallonia.

Funeral services were conducted at the Baptist church, of which she was a member, Sunday afternoon at two o'clock, the Rev. Jesse Nichols, pastor of the Pentacost church, officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery. Six ladies of the Pocahontas Lodge, Honoeye Council, No. 345, of which deceased was a member, acted as pallbearers.
