Hayes McIntosh, Well-Known Tampico Resident, Succumbs

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Tampico Baptist Church for Hayes R. McIntosh, 79, well-known resident of the Tampico community, who died at the Jackson county hospital Friday morning where he had been admitted the previous Monday for medical treatment.

He had been ill for a long time.

A native of Kentucky, Mr. McIntosh was born March 24, 1876, the son of the late Simon and Nancy McIntosh. He had lived in the Tampico community for almost a quarter of a century and was widely known throughout all of Jackson and surrounding counties where he appeared a number of years ago at county fairs with a team of oxen.

He was a member of the Tampico Baptist Church.

Surviving in addition to the widow, the former Miss Hannah Roberts, are five sons and four daughters. The sons are S. K. McIntosh, Detroit, Michigan; Brack McIntosh, Cincinnati, O.; James McIntosh, also of Detroit; Willard McIntosh, San Diego, California, and Harold McIntosh, at home. The daughters are Mrs. Lucille Gill, Toledo, Ohio; Mrs. Lillie Smith, Swanton, Ohio; Mrs. Clarice Hamilton, Cincinnati, and Mrs. Bertha Hill, of Tampico.

Also surviving are three sisters, Mrs. Amanda Rousch, Taft, California; Mrs. Laura Gebley, McKee, Kentucky and Mrs. Mallie Turner, Jackson, Kentucky.

The Rev. Glen McCalman, pastor of the Tampico Church, assisted by the Rev. John Cassidy, conducted the funeral rites and burial was in Fairview Cemetery in Brownstown.
