John P. McKain, 62, of Seymour Rt. 6 died at 11:22 p.m. Sunday, March 29, at Jackson County Hospital in Seymour.

Funeral services were scheduled at 2 p.m. today, Wednesday, April 1, at Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home in Brownstown where the Rev. Darrell Wineinger was to officiate. Burial was to be in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

The son of the late John R. and Bess Cockerham McKain was born Dec. 7, 1918, in Jackson County.

McKain was a Brownstown Baptist Church member, a second-world-war veteran and worked at Arvin Industries in Seymour for 22 years.

He is survived by his wife, the former Naomi Stout, whom he married in September, 1945, in Jackson County.

Other survivors include five children, Roland and John J., both of Seymour Rt. 6, Paul D. of Brownstown Rt. 1, Gary O. of Freetown Rt. 2 and Catherine Megel of Seymour Rt. 6.
