Roland McKain, 68, of Crothersville R1 died at 9:20 a.m. Tuesday at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis. He had been ill for several years.

He was a member of Tampico Baptist Church and a deacon of the church. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and retired in 1974 from Arvin Industries after 28 years there.

Mr. McKain was born on May 8, 1921, in Jackson County to John R. and Bess Cockerham McKain. He married Lorraine Smith on July 4, 1947, in Brownstown. She survives.
