Rites Held For Gerald McNiece, Jackson Native

Funeral services for Gerald W. McNiece, 52, of Indianapolis, a native of Jackson County and former teacher here, were conducted Monday afternoon in Indianapolis with burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. McNiece died Saturday afternoon at Winona Hospital, Indianapolis, after an illness of one month.

A graduate of Brownstown High School, he received his bachelor of science degree from Indiana Central College and his master's degree from Butler University.

He had taught in several one-room schools in Jackson County, including Hobson Hill School and Gossman School. He was in school administration in Indianapolis for the past 22 years and had served as principal of Grandview Elementary School there for the past 13 years.

He was a member of Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons, of Brownstown, and of the Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church.

During World War II, he served in the U. S. Air Force.

Born Oct. 21, 1916, in the Pleasant Grove community, he was the son of Mrs. Nell White McNiece, of Pleasant Grove, and the late Guy W. McNiece.

In 1946, at Brownstown, he married the former Helen Irene Forgey, of Freetown, who survives.

In addition to the widow and mother, he is survived by one son, William Lynn McNiece, of Indianapolis; one brother, Don McNiece, of Indianapolis; three sisters, Mrs. Esther Rorig, of Vallonia, Mrs. Ralph Par-dieck, of Seymour, and Miss Florence McNiece, of Indianapolis.
