Nellie "Nell" McNiece, 97, formerly of Pleasant Grove Community, died at 4:45 p.m. Friday, Aug. 19, at the Americana Midtown Nursing Home, Indianapolis. She had been ill for one year.

Mrs. McNiece taught elementary grades at the Surprise, Cortland, and Borchers Schools. She was also the oldest living alumnus of Cortland School. She attended the Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church and served as an organist at the Surprise Methodist Church. Mrs. McNiece was an active charter member of the Willing Workers Club.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, she was a twin born June 20, 1891, in Hamilton township north of Acme to the late Wesley and Kate Weekly White. On Nov. 11, 1915, she married Guy Whitcomb McNiece in Cortland, and he died March 12, 1963.

Survivors include four children: Mrs. Edgar (Esther) Rorig, Vallonia; Mrs. Ralph (Ruth) Pardieck, Seymour; Donald W. McNiece, Greenwood, and Florence McNiece, Indianapolis; six grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her twin brother Willie in 1894, and by two sons.

Funeral services were held Monday, Aug. 22, at the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Dallas Collier officiating. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
