NICHOLS—The remains of John Otis Nichols arrived here from Oolitic Monday evening and were taken to the home of his uncle, Rev. Jesse Nichols. Deceased was born in Brownstown May 4, 1886, and was a son of Louis Nichols and wife, both deceased. He died at his home at Oolitic Saturday, October 30, 1915, of tuberculosis, aged 29 years, 5 months and 26 days. He was united in marriage to Shirley Bennett, of Oolitic, February 16, 1908, and to their union were born two children, Frank and Flora Alice, who together with their mother are left to mourn

their loss. He also leaves one sister, Mrs. Flora Burkhardt, of Salem.

He was converted about a year ago since which time he lived a consistent christian life. He served in the regular army and was discharged about eight years ago. He was a member of the I. O. O. F. and Red Men lodges and was a highly respected young man.

Funeral services were conducted by the M. E. minister at the Mission church at Oolitic Monday and short services were conducted here at the home of Rev. Nichols Tuesday morning at 9:30 o'clock, after which the Red Men lodge of this place took charge of the services, followed by burial in Fairview cemetery.
