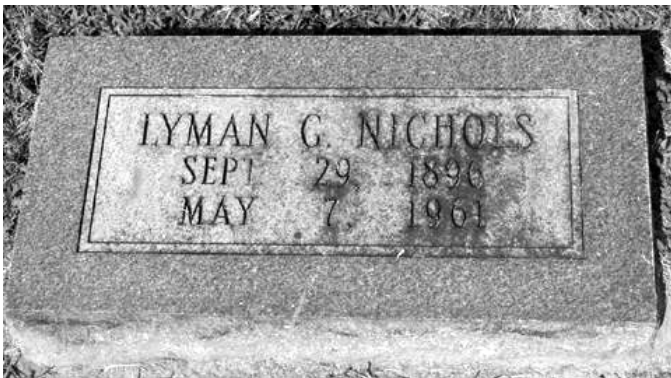

Lyman G. Nichols Dies— Ill 20 Years—Rites Held Here Tuesday

Funeral rites were held Tuesday afternoon from the Brownstown Methodist Church following prayer services at the Winklepleck Funeral Home, for Lyman G. Nichols, 64.

Ill for twenty years, Mr. Nichols died at 3:00 o'clock Sunday morning at the family home on U. S. Highway 50, in the Crane Hill neighborhood, east of Brownstown.

The Rev. Ernest Jones, Brownstown Methodist pastor, was in charge of the rites. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery here.

Mr. Nichols was born in Brownstown, September 29, 1896, a son of the late William H. and Lillian Ruth England Nichols, and had spent all of his life in the Brownstown area and Seymour.

He was married here, February 28, 1928, to Sylvia Rinehart, who survives as do three children, a son, Charles Rinehart, of Brownstown, and two daughters, Mrs. Helen Moles of Indianapolis, and Mrs. Carolyn Williams, of Columbus.

Also surviving are seven grandchildren, a niece, Martha Ruth Cartwright, who makes her home with the Nichols, and a sister, Mrs. Walter Zimmerman, of Seymour.

Two brothers and two sisters are deceased.

Mr. Nichols was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church, and, until failing health limited his activities, was a farmer.
