Charles C. Nowling Dies—Funeral Tuesday

Charles C. Nowling, 83, a resident of Jackson county most of his life, died at 3:30 o'clock Sunday morning at the home of his brother, George Nowling, of Brownstown, with whom he made his home. Death followed only a day's illness with a heart attack.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Eldon Cornett, pastor of the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
