Willard Walter Nowling, 70, of 515 S. Main St. in Brownstown died at home Saturday night, Dec. 24.

Death was a result of a heart attack, said the county coroner, Keith Burkholder. Mr. Nowling was found Sunday morning by a nephew.

Funeral will begin at 2 p.m. today, Wednesday, Dec. 28, at the Spurgeon Funeral Home at Brownstown and burial will be at Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.

Persons may call at the funeral home from 9 a.m. until time of the service today.

The carpenter and former Shell Oil Co. employee at Indianapolis for 25 years was a veteran of World War II. Military graveside rites were performed by the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1925 of Seymour.

Born April 24, 1914, in Jackson County, Nowling was a son of the late George and Della Mae Gaiter Nowling. He married the former Myrtle L. Salmon in Indianapolis in 1946, and she died in August, 1957.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Bernard (Ruth) Tiemeyer of Brownstown; two nephews, Leonard Stinson and Ed Tiemeyer; and a niece, Diana Green.

Nowling was preceded in death by a brother and a sister.

He was a member of Oriental Lodge 500 of the Free and Accepted Masons of Indianapolis.
