## Charles Brock Owens Succumbs At Hospital

Charles Brock Owens, 53, of Brownstown, died at 6:57 a. m. today at Schneck Memorial Hospital. He had been admitted to the hospital several hours earlier for medical treatment. He had been ill since July.

Born February 18, 1905 in Driftwood township, he was the son of the late Harvey and Maude Boley Owens and had lived in Brownstown most of his life.

Employed by the Jackson County REMC for the past eight years, Mr. Owens was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and was very active in church activities.

On July 12, 1936, he married the former Ruth Mae Blackwood, at Brownstown. The widow survives.

Also surviving are two sons, James William and Charles Dean Owens, both at home; two brothers, John Raymond and Gerald Dean Owens, both of Indianapolis, and two sisters, Mrs. Catherine Silence, Brownstown R2, and Mrs. Lola Mae Pilman, Indianapolis.
