Owens—David Newton Owens, age 64 years, passed away suddenly at his home in Brownstown Friday morning at 6 o'clock of heart trouble.

About two years ago Mr. Owens suffered a stroke since which time he had been in declining health. He was able to be up and about and seemed no worse Friday morning than usual. He got up and dressed and sat in a rocking chair. His children noticed he was sick and Dr. Cummings was called, but he passed away before he reached the home.

Mr. Owens spent his entire life in Jackson county. He was the son of James and Catherine Owens, both deceased, and was born December 16, 1869. He was of a quiet disposition and well liked by all who knew him. He was a member of the Missionary church.

On December 31, 1898, he was married to Miss Iva England, who died in 1925.

Surviving are four children, Cecil Jesse, Gertrude and Faye Owens, all at home; two brothers, Harve Owens, of Brownstown; Tom Owens, of La-Porte; one uncle, Sherman Owens, of Brownstown, and an aunt, Mrs. Annie Ritchie, Scottsburg.
