

## Claude Perry Funeral Held at Brownstown

Funeral services for Claude Perry, age fifty-seven, who suffered a fatal heart attack Monday afternoon while working on a fance at the Fred Gossman farm one-half mile southwest of Brownstown, were conducted this afternoon from the Brownstown Church of the Nazarene with the Rev. C. A. Newby in charge. Burial was in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Perry was born at Austin on January 7, 1886, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Perry, both deceased. On December 24, 1915, he was married to Bernice Silence, who survives. He was a member of the Austin Christian Church. The family had lived in Brownstown township for the past six years.
