Fractured Hip Proves Fatal To Mrs. Dan Morgan

A fractured hip, suffered Sunday, August 2, proved fatal early Friday evening to 83-year-old Mrs. Dan Morgan, who lived on U. S. 50, at the top of Crane Hill, east of Brownstown.

Mrs. Morgan died at the Jackson County hospital where she had undergone orthopedic surgery for the hip injury on Thursday.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson county, Mrs. Morgan, the former Rosanna Persinger, was born August 17, 1876, one of seven children of the late Henry and Mary Robertson Persinger.

She was twice married. Her first marriage was to Frank Peters, who died in 1931. Later she married Dan Morgan, who has been deceased since 1942.

An only child, Harlan A. Peters, also is deceased, as are three brothers and two sisters.

A sister, Mrs. Andrew Fosbrink, R. R., Brownstown survives.

Mrs. Morgan was critically injured in an automobile accident in Brownstown in October, 1957, and was hospitalized at that time for several months.

She was a member of Brownstown Christian Church.

Funeral rites were held Monday afternoon from the Voss Chapel, Seymour, in charge of E. Lacy Satterfield, Brownstown Christian pastor. Interment was in Fairview Cemetery, here
