Mrs. Opal Pferrer Dies Thurs. After Lingerin Illness

Death came to Mrs. Opal Pferrer shortly before midnight Thursday at the home of her mother, Mrs. Ora Davis, where she had been bedfast since undergoing surgery six months ago last Wednesday.

Funeral rites were held at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon in the Brownstown Christian Church, in charge of the pastor, Gene Dulin, and interment was in Fairview Cemetery.

Born in Brownstown, September 3, 1910, a daughter of Mrs. Beatrice Bland Davis, and the late Ora Davis, she had spent all her life here. She was graduated from the Brownstown Consolidated High School and on July 3, 1932, was married in Brownstown to Charles Pferrer, who survives.

For several years she had been a linotype operator with The Brownstown Banner.

A member of the Brownstown Christian Church since girlhood, and actively identified in many of its auxiliary groups, Opal's life reflected her high Christian ideals, and her kindness, sincerity and thoughtfulness of others endeared her to everyone who knew her.

Surviving in addition to her mother and husband, are three children, Joe R. Pferrer, a member of the Brownstown High School Senior Class, Richard W. Pferrer and Linda Sue Pferrer, and a sister, Mrs. Rolland Griffiths, of Columbus. In addition to her father, a brother, William Davis, preceded her in death.
