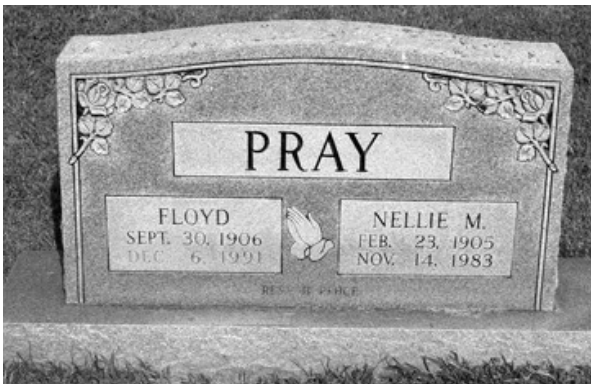

Floyd Pray Sr. services Tuesday

Floyd Pray Sr., 85, of Brownstown was pronounced dead on arrival at 2:55 p.m. Friday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital.

He was a self-employed electrician and a member of Brownstown Christian Church and Knights of Pythias.

He was born Sept. 30, 1906, in Medora, to Albert F. and Bertie Weddle Pray. He was married April 23, 1927, in Brownstown to Nellie Mae Trowbridge, who died Nov. 14, 1983.
