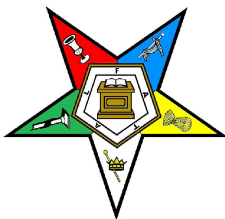
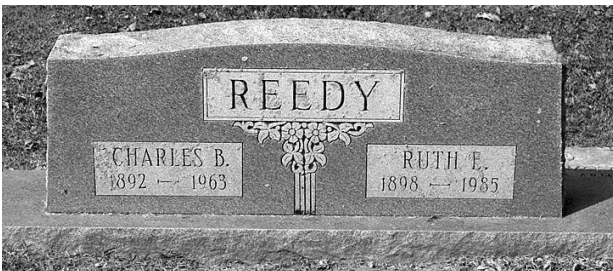

Heart Attack Fatal To Charles Reedy Early This Morning

Charles Reedy, 70, Freetown, R1, well-known resident of that community, succumbed suddenly at 8:45 o'clock this morning at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Lucas, who live close to the Reedy home.

Mr. Reedy had gone there to do some farm work.

According to Deputy County Coroner Omer Owens, who was called, death was due to a heart attack.

Mr. Reedy had been in failing health for the past two years.

He was born November 12, 1892, a son of the late Albert Kee and Donna Reedy. On November 21, 1917, he was married to Ruth Ackeret, who survives.

Also surviving are a son, Albert K. Reedy, Newburg, New York; a daughter, Mrs. Kenneth Lucas, Columbus; a foster son, James Mails, of Seymour; six grandchildren; one great-grandchild; a brother, Ralph Reedy, of Freetown; three half-brothers, George Loper, Crothersville, Ross Loper, Brownstown, and Orville Loper, Freetown; two sisters, Mrs. Ida Patrick, of Seymour, and Mrs. Effie Richards, of Brownstown, and a half-sister, Miss Marie McElfresh, of Brownstown.

Mr. Reedy was a carpenter for thirty-five years. Following his retirement from this trade he had done farming.

He was a member of the Ratcliff Grove Christian Church, Washington Lodge No. 13, Free & Accepted Masons, of Brownstown, and Brownstown Chapter, Order of Eastern Star.
