FORMER TEACHER IN SEYMOUR DIES

Miss Amelia Reich Passes Away
This Morning At Home In
Brownstown.

TAUGHT TEN YEARS IN CITY

Miss Amelia Reich, aged fifty-four, former instructor in the grade schools in Seymour, died this morning of jaundice, at her home in Brownstown, after an illness of more than six months.

Miss Reich was born in Seymour on August 15, 1871. She was graduated from the Seymour high school and was further educated for her teaching career at the Normal school in Terre Haute and the the Bryant-Stratton Business College in Louisville.

years Miss Reich taught in the grade schools here. She moved from Seymour to Louisville where she was an instructor for some time in the business college in which she had received training.

About ten years ago the family moved to Brownstown. There Miss Reich taught in the Junior and Senior High School until compelled to retire because of the illness which caused her death.

Miss Reich was a member of the Presbyterian church in Brownstown.

She was well known in Seymour and had a large number of friends here. Miss Katherine Vosbrink, 628 South Walnut street, was a very close friend of Miss Reich.

Surviving Miss Reich are her mother, Mrs. George Reich, of Brownstown; one sister, Miss Alma Reich, of Brownstown, and one brother, Charles Reich, of Louisville.

Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the home. Burial will be made in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.
