Paris Reinbold Funeral Tuesday

Funeral services for Paris A. Reinbold, 65, a resident of Jackson County until several years ago, will be conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday from the Winklepleck Funeral Home in Brownstown.

The Rev. Merlin Schwein, district superintendent of the Methodist Church, will officiate, assisted by the Rev. Max Nicolson, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Reinbold died Friday at 5:30 p. m. at Northwest Hospital, Glendale, Ariz. He had been in ill health for several months.

On July 26, 1922, at Medora he married the former Nona Kent, who survives.
