Ramon P. "Speck" Reinbold, 76, of 821 S. Main St., Brownstown, died at 4:30 p.m. Wednesday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital, Seymour. He had been ill for five years.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, he owned Reinbold's Grocery in Brownstown for 34 years, and he operated a gas station in Brownstown for several years. He retired in 1980 from the State Highway Department.

Born Dec. 3, 1913, in Brownstown, he was the son of John Andy and Nora Alvina (Cordell) Reinbold. He married Violet Loreen Speer on Sept. 30, 1939. She preceded him in death on Nov. 29, 1969. He married Leona J. Stewart on Dec. 31, 1980. She survives.
