Thomas L. Reinbold, 74, Brownstown, died Sunday, June 23, at Clark County Hospital, Jeffersonville.

Born Nov. 22, 1899, at Brownstown, he was the son of the late C.T. and Grace Vinson Reinbold.

He married Ruth Spurgeon on Dec. 15, 1923, at Brownstown, and she died April 19, 1968.

A lifelong Brownstown resident, he retired after working in the Railway Postal Mail Service for 30 years. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of the Brownstown United Methodist Church, Camp Jackson Post 112, American Legion, and Washington Lodge 13, Free and Accepted Masons. He was a former Republican precinct committeeman.
