

Mrs. Reinbold, Of Brownstown, Dies At 51

Funeral services for Mrs. Raymond (Violet) Reinbold, 51, 821 South Main street, Brownstown, will be conducted at 2 p. m. Tuesday from the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home in Brownstown with the Rev.
