Aline Lucille Lucas Reynolds, 92, of Brownstown, Indiana, passed away at 5:27 p.m. Wednesday, December 15, 2010 at Hoosier Christian Village in Brownstown.

Aline was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church since September 3, 1938 and was active in the Esther Society and Golden Wheels with the church. She had been employed as a switchboard operator in Brownstown for the Indiana Telephone Corporation and was also a clerk at Nierman & Kuehn's clothing store in Brownstown. She was a 1936 graduate of Brownstown High School, a member of the Beta Mu Chapter of Psi Iota Xi sorority and its auxiliary; a member and Past Matron of the Order of Eastern Star No. 264; a member of the Columbus, Indiana Chapter of the Model-A Restorers Club of America; and a member of the Brownstown Unit 1 Extension Homemakers.

Born September 23, 1918 in Brownstown, she was a daughter of Allan Lee and Orpha Lockman Lucas. On August 15, 1937, in Brownstown, she married Wharton Wesley Reynolds who preceded in death November 9, 1993. He was a son of Rev. J.C. and Lillian Oleva Spurgeon Reynolds. Wharton and Aline were married at the home of Aline's parents and the ceremony was officiated by Wharton's father.
