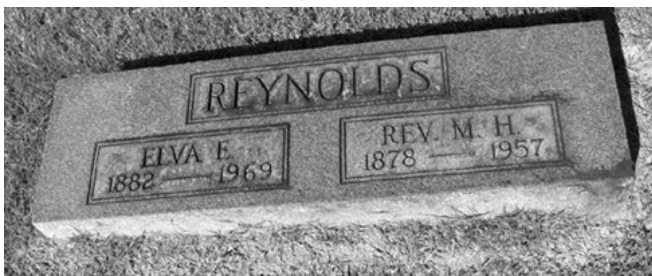

Graveside Rites Held Here For Mrs. Meade Reynolds

Graveside rites were held Thursday afternoon in Fairview Cemetery for Mrs. Meade Reynolds, of Indianapolis, a former resident of Jackson County and a sister-in-law of Mrs. William Schwein, of Browns-town.

The committal service was given by the Rev. Staten E. Lightfoot, pastor of Brownstown United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Reynolds, who was the former Miss Elva Ruddick, of Seymour, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frank Ruddick, died in Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis, Tuesday of last week. She had been in and out of the hospital and Indianapolis nursing homes during most of the past year.

Funeral services were held in Indianapolis Tuesday, in charge of the Rev. Johnson, pastor of the Roberts Park United Methodist Church, and the funeral party left immediately for the cemetery here.

Mrs. Reynolds was the widow of the Rev. Meade Reynolds, at one time a widely-known Methodist minister in Jackson County, serving Methodist churches in Freetown, Houston and Kurtz prior to be assigned to larger Methodist Churches in Indianapolis.

Surviving are three sons, Frank H. Reynolds, prominent Indianapolis florist; Marshall Reynolds, of Indianapolis, and Glen Reynolds, of New York; two daughters, Mrs. Gertrude Gobin and Mrs. Juanita Hancock, both living in Indianapolis, and a number of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Reynolds was an aunt of Melvin Schwein, Mrs. James P. Heller, Reynolds Gossman and Archie Gossman, of Browns-town.
