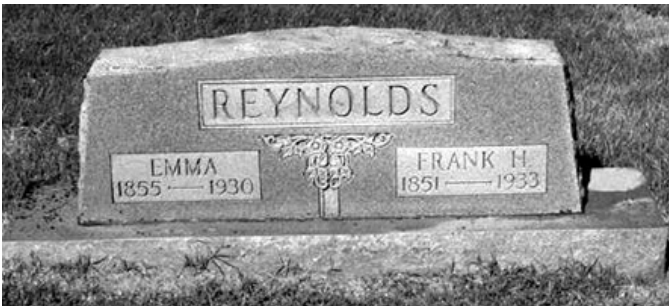

Mrs. Emma Reynolds Dies This Afternoon

Reynolds—Mrs. Emma Reynolds, wife of the Rev. Frank Reynolds, passed away at her home, three miles west of Brownstown, this afternoon at 12:30 o'clock, aged 74 years. She had been sick with a complication of diseases for several years.

Funeral services will be held at the Pleasant Grove Methodist church Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Reynolds was born in Jackson county March 10, 1856, and was married to Rev. Reynolds August 14, 1876. To their union were born eight children, one of whom preceded her in death.

Besides her husband she leaves the following children: Mrs. Frankie Schwein and Mrs. Orpha Gossman, of Brownstown; Cecil, Ray, Rev. Meade Reynolds and Mrs. Blanche Gollmeier, all of Indianapolis; Geo.
