## Mrs. Lillian Reynolds Dies, Rites Planned

Mrs. Lillian Oleva Reynolds, 85, 306 North Poplar street, Brownstown, died at 7:45 a. m. this morning at the Jackson Park Convalescent Center after an illness of two weeks.

She was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church and of Chapter No. 264, Order of Eastern Star, there.

Born Sept. 23, 1885, in Salem, she was the daughter of the late James and Nancy Soliday Spurgeon.

On July 3, 1903, in Jackson County, she married Jesse C. Reynolds, who died in July 1938. Mr. Reynolds was a Christian minister and had served a number of churches in the northern part of the state.

Surviving are three sons, Willard S., of Hollywood, Fla., Ferris E., of Elon College, N. C., and Wharton W., Brownstown teacher; one sister, Mrs. Hattie Brown, of Salem; six grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren. Two brothers preceded her in death.
