

Wharton Wesley Reynolds, 79, of Brownstown died at 10:20 a.m. Tuesday at Indiana University Medical Center, Indianapolis, after a 30-day illness.

He was a teacher for Brownstown schools from 1935 to his retirement in 1978.

He had served on the Hoosier Christian Village Board of Trustees, Brownstown, and was a member of the Indiana Retired Teachers Association, the Model-A Restorers Club in Columbus, the Scottish Rite, the Jackson County Scottish Rite Club, and Masonic Lodge 13, Tally Hi Euchre Club and Exchange Club, all of Brownstown.

He was a member of Brownstown Christian Church, where he taught Sunday school for many years and served on the church board.
