Mrs. Ola Rich, 80, Dies Following Fall

Mrs. Ola A. Rich, of Brownstown, died in the Schneck Memorial Hospital early this morning after suffering a broken hip in a fall at her home Monday, which was her eightieth birthday anniversary.

She had been ill for six months prior to the accident.

Mrs. Rich was born October 29, 1871, daughter of the late Thomas and Julia Coon Smith. On April 16, 1887, she was married at Brownstown to Ralph Rich who died about seven years ago. She spent her entire life in Jackson county and was a faithful member of the Brownstown Christian Church. Many friends throughout her native town and county mourn her death.

Survivors include two sons, Floyd Rich, of Bedford, and Everett Rich, of Scottsburg; two daughters, Mrs. Clara McKain, of Brownstown, and Miss Georgia Rich, at home; one brother, Lonzo Smith, three sisters, Mrs. Minnie King, Mrs. Pearl Burrell and Mrs. Mattie Barkman, all of Brownstown; 14 grandchildren, and 16 great-grandchildren.
