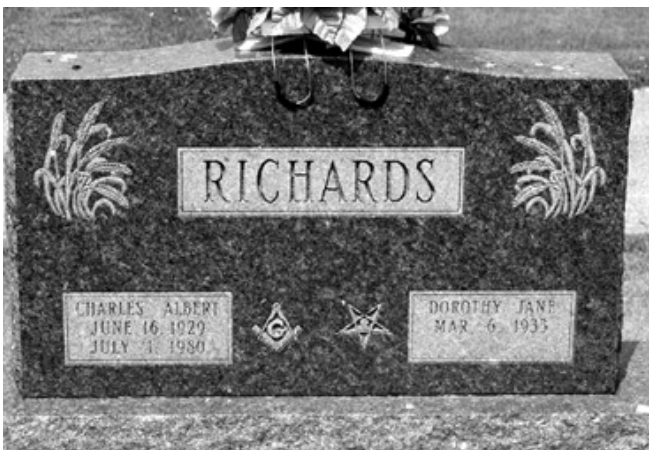

## Charles Richards

Charles A. Richards, 51, a Jackson County native, died at 11 p.m. Tuesday at home of an apparent heart attack.

He was a Navy veteran of the Korean War. He had been employed by Public Service Indiana for 27 years.

A resident of Noblesville when he died, he was born in Jackson County on June 16, 1929, son of the late Clarence and Effie Reedy Richards. He married Dorothy Empsom on Sept. 4, 1954, in Jackson County. She survives.
