Clarence Richards, 63, Dies Today At Hospital

Clarence Richards, 63-year-old Brownstown R1 farmer, died at 5:15 a. m. today in Schneck Memorial Hospital. He had been in ill health for about four years and suffered a stroke Monday after he was admitted to the hospital for medical treatment.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson County, he was born April 3, 1897, to the late Berry and Narra Smallwood Richards.

Mr. Richards was a veteran of World War I and a member of the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church and Camp Jackson Post No. 112, American Legion, Brownstown.

On June 13, 1926, he married the former Effie Reedy. The widow survives.

Also surviving are four sons, Harry Richards, Blytheville, Ark., Charles Richards, Seymour, Howard Richards, Indianapolis, and Paul Richards, Columbus; and six grandchildren.

Mr. Richards was preceded in death by three brothers.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p. m. Sunday from the Pleasant Grove Methodist Church. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown, where military rites will be conducted by the Camp Jackson Post and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post, No. 7755, Brownstown.
