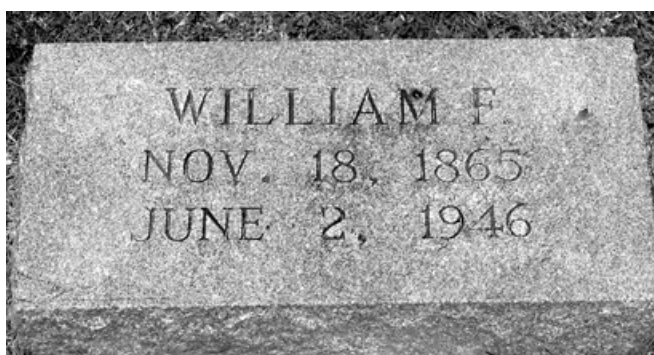

County Banker Succumbs Sunday

**William F. Richards,
Head of Brownstown
Concern, Ill Two Days**

William F. Richards, president of the Brownstown Loan and Trust Company and a member of the Jackson county council, died late Sunday night at his home in Brownstown at the age of eighty.

Mr. Richards had been ill for only two days, and died after suffering a heart attack.

He had been president of the Brownstown Loan and Trust Company for twenty-five years, and had been a farmer and stock buyer in Indiana. He was a member of the Jackson county council for about twenty-five years.

He was widely known over the county and state, and was very active in civic affairs at Brownstown.

Mr. Richards was born November 19, 1865, near Brownstown, the son of Samuel Richards and Sarah Hunsucker Richards, who preceded him in death.

He lived all of his life in and near Brownstown, and was married November 8, 1910, at Indianapolis, to Myrtle Workman, who survives.

Besides the widow, other survivors include one son, William H. Richards, of Cincinnati, and one brother, Meade Richards, of Farmington, Mo.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Central Standard Time, from the home in Brownstown with the Rev. Kenneth Smith, Presbyterian minister from Louisville, in charge. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery at Brownstown.
