## **Mrs. Rinehart Dies at Home**

Mrs. Eva Rinehart, age seventy-eight, a life-long resident of Jackson county, died at her home, an apartment at 300 South Walnut street, at 5 o'clock Monday morning. Death followed a six weeks' illness with dropsy.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 o'clock Wednesday morning from the Wallace Funeral Home at Brownstown with the Rev. R. M. Dodrill, pastor of the Broadway Baptist Church, Indianapolis, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
