Ex-Brownstown Man Dies in Indianapolis

Leo Rinehart, age sixty-three, a former resident of Brownstown, died early this morning at his home at 1509 Rembrandt street, Indianapolis, following an illness of three weeks' duration. Death was due to a complication of diseases.

Born in February, 1880, at the Crane homestead on the Brownstown-Seymour road, Mr. Rinehart spent much of his life in this vicinity. He was married to Maud Boling, of Indianapolis, who survives.

He had many friends in this community who regret to hear of his passing, as well as a wide circle of friends in Indianapolis.

Survivors include the widow; one son, Chester Rinehart, of Indianapolis; one brother, Ed Rinehart, of Indianapolis; one sister, Mrs. Nettie Jones, of Norman; and two aunts, Mrs. Warren Skinner, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Nannie Collins, of Indianapolis.

Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed, but rites will be conducted from the Brownstown Baptist Church, and burial will be in the Brownstown Cemetery.
