Obituary

Mrs. Maude Jeanette Robbins died at her home here Sunday, March 1, 1942. She had been in ill health for some time. About five years ago she suffered a stroke and last Friday her condition became critical.

Funeral services, in charge of the Rev. L. R. Morlen, were conducted at the Pleasant Grove church Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock. Burial in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Robbins was the daughter of Mrs. Barbara Hotz, who preceded her in death about six years ago. She was born near Norman January 9, 1885, making her age at the time of her death 57 years, 1 month and 19 days. On October 7, 1902, she was united in marriage to Dawson Robbins.
