Mrs. Ruth M. Robbins, 80, of 314 S. Main St., Brownstown, died at 10:35 a.m. Monday, March 12, at the Lutheran Community Home, Seymour, where she had been a resident for four years.

A lifelong resident of Jackson County, Mrs. Robbins was born Aug. 11, 1898, to the late George R. and Emma Winkler Shelton. On Dec. 9, 1920, at Scottsburg, she married John M. Robbins, who preceded her in death on Aug. 23, 1968.

Mrs. Robbins retired from the Indiana Telephone Corporation after 25 years of service during which she was chief operator and supervisor. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Brownstown Order of Eastern Star, and Unit I Extension Homemakers Club of Brownstown.
